RECYCLE/YARD WASTE SITE RULES
701 Progress Drive

The following rules must be followed when using the recycle/yard waste site:

1. SCRAP METAL - No Glass, Plastic, Wood, Or Any Material Other Than Metal. Call Advanced Disposal 262-367-6040 for Pick Up of Air Conditioners and Other Freon Appliances.
2. NEWSPAPER, CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PAPER, UNWANTED MAIL - Newspapers, Corrugated Cardboard, Phone Books, Glossy Magazines, Catalogs, Laundry Detergent Boxes, Soda & Beer Cartons, Cereal Boxes, Household Mail, Computer, Copy and Writing Paper . Also, Paper Egg Cartons, Brown Grocery Bags, Toilet Paper /Paper Towel Tubes and Tissue Boxes.
Do Not Bring Food Contaminated Paper or Boxes . No Carbon Copy or Blue Prints, Stickers and Plastics, Styrofoam or Packing Material.
3. ALUMINUM, STEEL, TIN CANS - Includes Empty Aerosol Cans, Pots & Pans, Clean Foil & Pans.
No Paint or Pesticide Cans, Aluminum Foil Contaminated with Food Waste or Clothes Hangers

GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS - No Window Glass, Ceramic Dishes, Light Bulbs, Drinking Glasses

PLASTICS - Code 1, 2, 4, 5 & 7 Bottles (water, soda, juice), Jugs (detergent, milk, juice, cleaning products, cooking oil), Tubs (margarine, sour cream, yogurt), Deli, Berry & Produce Containers, Cups and Lids.

Large Rigid Plastics (Remove all metal components) – Plastic Buckets (5 gallon ice cream, kitty litter), Laundry Baskets, Plastic Crates, Plastic Dish Drying Racks.

No Motor Oil, Antifreeze Bottles, Pesticide Bottles, Foam Containers, plastic bags or salt bags.
4. YARD WASTE - Includes Grass Clippings, Leaves, Brush (6" diameter maximum, 6' length maximum), Garden Trimmings/Plants Only. Do Not Bring Landscape Timbers, Lumber, Rocks, Sod, Gravel, Flower Pots, Stumps, Root Balls and Other Trash Mixed In With Yard Waste

Plastic Bags Or Other Containers Must be Removed from the Site.
5. WASTE OIL - Used Motor Oil and Oil Filters Only. Do Not Bring a Mix with Gasoline, Antifreeze or Other Compounds, Containers **Must be Taken Back for Reuse**
6. ANTIFREEZE - Used Antifreeze Only. Do Not Bring A Mix with Other Compounds
7. ELECTRONIC WASTE- Collection of Electronic Waste has been suspended until further notice .
8. Only Village residents can use yard waste site. You must show driver's license or ID. showing residence within Village limits.
9. Persons living outside the Village can only use the electronic waste, paper/cardboard, plastic, aluminum, glass, can and scrap metal containers; waste oil and antifreeze depositories.
10. No contractors are allowed to use the site.
11. No businesses, commercial or industrial, are allowed to use the site, except for small firms that generate residential type quantities on a weekly basis.
12. Village residents may not bring large volumes of brush such as that generated by clearing a lot for new home construction.
13. Anyone, residents and nonresidents, may take chips, compost or firewood when available, free of charge.
14. **This is not a dumpsite.** Do not bring tires, lumber, windows, engines, lawnmowers, or any other items other than those listed. Call Advanced Disposal-Veolia I Services for instructions on possible curbside pickup at 262-367-6040.
15. **Invasive Weeds: Bag them in CLEAR PLASTIC Bags, label them "Invasive Plants – Please Landfill", and set them out with the garbage. DO NOT bring to recycle center.**

Please DO NOT bring propane tanks, asphalt waste, concrete blocks or waste, and bricks!
