Meeting called to order: 6:00 pm

1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of July 12, 2017. After noticing the following corrections to the July 12, 2017 minutes: Van De Ven not Podszus will be taking a group of individuals who are retired out for hikes. A motion was made, seconded and passed (Van De Ven/Dr. Muenzenberger)
2. Discussion and consideration of:
  - a. Library Programs - no discussion
  - b. Recreational programs – Yogerst is still working on getting REI to do some classes on the Ice Age Trail. Yogerst is also working with her yoga instructor to offer classes on the Ice Age Trail. Romagna will be offering a walking club on the Ice Age Trail that will start on Wednesday, September 13. The first day will consist of walking from the Hartland Public Library to Centennial Park. The walking club will meet every 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month. If there is a good turnout, more days can be offered. The program will be offered in December and January. The walking club will meet for a few hours from 10:00 am – noon. The program will be advertised as advanced registration, but will accept walk ups. All ages can participate. Dogs can come too, except for the first one from the Library to Centennial Park.
  - c. Website for Hartland on IATC site – update from the IATC Website Committee members – Website Committee is meeting on Tuesday, August 15, 2017. It was noted that photos were added to the website since the last draft. Van De Ven mentioned that Podszus might be upset that one panel is dropped. The Village of Hartland IATC website is currently up on the Ice Age Trail Alliance website. Dr. Muenzenberger said now we have to fine tune it, but it has some good information on it and well represented on the site.
  - d. Trail signage/education - The Committee is waiting on the URL. Website committee will talk to Luke Kloberdanz and Lysianne Unruh, both from the Ice Age Trail Alliance, about developing an URL for the Village of Hartland Ice Age Trail website. The website committee will ask Kloberdanz and Unruh what they can do to drive people directly to Village of Hartland Ice Age Trail website. Once the URL is established, the IATC website committee will discuss where they want to put the signs. The goal is to make a URL that is short in length and it will take you directly to the Village of Hartland website.

- e. IATC Partner Program – Pamphlet/Letter – Dr. Muenzenberger mentioned that Podszus is going to talk to Cindy Gardner, Village of Hartland’s Business Improvement Director, but that is on hold right now.
  - f. Kiosk update – Van De Ven has not been able to get a hold of Jack Sullivan and Bethany Sullivan. Once Van De Ven finds the information Van de Ven will reach out to the cabinet maker. Van De Ven will ask J. Sullivan and B. Sullivan for an update on the Centennial Park Kiosk. Van De Ven will still try to get all the information that J. Sullivan has collected. Georgson mentioned that Delafield is building a kiosk. Van De Ven requested for Georgson to find out who is building Delafield’s Kiosk and see if they would build the kiosk in Nixon Park. Van De Ven will get in contact with the builder once he receives the information from J. Sullivan and B. Sullivan.
  - g. Future Promotional Events – Dr. Muenzenberger asked about the pamphlets that Delafield printed and distributed during the US Open in June. Some questions were raised: If there are any extra can the Village of Hartland have some? Do we want more of them? Or is there any need for Hartland to do something similar to what Delafield did in regards to those pamphlets?
  - h. Update on the boardwalk by Maple - Still not done. Arrowhead built the frame. Van De Ven wanted to know if any help is needed. Van Thiel will check to see if there is anything they need.
3. Other items for follow up as necessary
    - a. Connection with/to schools – Van Thiel can talk to somebody about doing something with the schools. One thought is to do a school hike on the weekends. Kids and parents could do this on Saturday mornings.
  4. Future meeting topics and meeting schedule – Meetings will be held the first Weds of the months; September 6, October, 4, November 1 and December 6.
