Meeting called to order: 6:00 pm

1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of August 9, 2017. A motion was moved to approve the August 9, 2017 meeting minutes. Second and passed (Muenzenberger/Van Thiel)
2. Discussion and consideration of:
  - a. Library Programs - no discussion
  - b. Recreational programs - Walking club is starting next Wednesday, September 13, 2017. REI and Yoga on the trail, Yogerst said programs will be in summer. Georgson mentioned at the last Chapter meeting that Tina Prick from REI is interested in supporting a walk from Delafield to Hartland.
  - c. Website for Hartland on IATC site – update from the IATC Website Committee members – Muenzenberger presented an update on how the website is coming along. Delafield, Hartland and Manitowoc are up and running on the Ice Age Trail Alliance site. The tiles for the Village of Hartland site are not in the order the members would like them to be. The computer program used for the Ice Age Trail Communities website arranges the tiles alphabetically. Muenzenberger will be meeting Miranda Weston, local photographer, on Friday, September 8, 2017 to talk about getting more photos for the website. It was also mentioned that the Ice Age Trail Community websites are also listed alphabetically, so Hartland will not be listed first.
  - d. It was the Hartland Business Improvement District, BID, is working on developing an app that the Ice Age Trail Alliance could use to help promote the Ice Age Trail.
  - e. Trail signage/education – waiting on the URL.
  - f. IATC Partner Program – Pamphlet/Letter – It was mentioned that there is another BID social on October 12 at Birch & Banyan. This might be a good opportunity to have some Ice Age Trail Community Committee members attend. Ms. Perrigo stated she can hand out IAT pamphlets at the Hartland Chamber. Ms. Perrigo will ask Lynn Minturn, Hartland Chamber of Commerce Director, if the chamber can hand out the partner pamphlet at the Chamber of Commerce. Georgson stated the grant money from the Ice Age Trail Alliance needs to be used up. The grant money needs to be used by the end of the year. One thought that was given was to use the grant money put the Ice Age Trail Community website's URL on signs.
