

## MINUTES

**ICE AGE TRAIL COMMUNITY COMMITTEE AGENDA

Present: Dr. Jim Muenzenberger, Dave Van Thiel, Rod Podszuz, Dave Van DeVen, Jeff Romagna, Jeannie Georgson, Kelli Yogerst and Cindy Bong, Hartland Chamber of Commerce Representative.

Meeting called to order at 6:00 pm

1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of October 4, 2017. A motion was moved to approve the October 4, 2017 meeting minutes with the following changes to the minutes. Section 3. A. Van Thiel sent a text to the teacher he knows at Hartland South Elementary, not Hartland North Elementary, as it was stated in the minutes. The other change requested is Jeff Romagna was not present for the October 4, 2017 meeting. Motion/second (Muenzenberger/Podszuz).
2. Discussion and consideration of:
  - a. Library programs - Kelli Yogerst will talk to Sara Swanson, Hartland Library staff and Peter Dargatz about offering some Tyke Hikes that start at the Hartland Public Library and in other locations in Hartland in 2018.
  - b. Recreational programs - The December Walking Club will consist of a historic tour. Yogerst will talk to Tina Pickruhn from REI, about possible future programs. REI cannot lead a program, but can give support to programs that are being offered. Yogerst will be meeting with the Hartland Recreation Department's Yoga and Barre Strength instructors about doing a Yoga and Boot Camp on the Ice Age Trail.
  - c. Website for Hartland on IATC site – update from the IATC Website Committee members. The next meeting will be on Friday, November 17 to go through all the photos that have been taken.
  - d. Trail signage/education – Dr. Jim Muenzenberger looked into getting a URL address for the Village of Hartland's Ice Age Trail Community webpage. Dr. Muenzenberger reported that the website addresses that were found were not small nor ideal. Dr. Muenzenberger brought up using a QR Code or a snapchat for the IATC website. One thought was to revisit with Luke Kloberdanz, from the Ice Age Trail Alliance, in regards to why he doesn't want them to be used. Muenzenberger is also waiting to receive the quotes from Signarama.
  - e. IATC Partner Program – Pamphlet/Letter – An update on the October 12, 2017 meeting was given. A lot of attendees who attended were already part of the program.
  - f. Kiosk update – Van De Ven found a company who will construct the bulletin boards for the Nixon Park Kiosk for over \$2,300 apiece/per two sided bulletin board. Geoff Luetschwager, teacher from Arrowhead, would have his students

build the Kiosk in the school and then bring it over to Nixon to put it up. A question was raised if the Village of Hartland DPW Department would be able to install the 14' x 14' concrete slab for the kiosk. Another question was raised that if the Village of Hartland can't, would the Ice Age Trail Community Committee Yogerst will talk to Ryan about taking the \$1500 that is for the kiosk to be used next year, if we can put it in a kitty.

- g. Discussion on installing selfie Kiosk along the Ice Age Trail –The Boy Scout that Yogerst knows has already found an Eagle Scout project. Yogerst will ask Jackie Perrigo to pursue pricing for the selfie kiosks.
- h. Use of Grant money from the Ice Age Trail Alliance - Updated the Ice Age Trail Community Committee members on the discussion Yogerst had with Celtic, designer firm that developed the poster that is in the City of Delafield's Kiosk along the Ice Age Trail that runs through the City of Delafield. Dr. Muenzenberger is going to talk to marketing people he knows to see if they can design the same poster that Delafield Kiosk in their Kiosk. Yogerst will ask Kloberdanz if the Ice Age Trail Community Committee can have the artwork that was used in the Delafield's Kiosk to design the poster for the Nixon Park Kiosk.
- i. Future Promotional Events – no discussion.

3. Other items for follow up as necessary

- a. Connection with/to schools – Courtney Marschalek, Hartland Lakeside School District's School Nationalist and member of the Village of Hartland's Environmental Corridor and Open Space Task Force Committee attended to discuss programs and special events that she could do for children. One idea is to run toddler hikes from April through October and maybe collaborate the adult hike with the smaller kids. Goal is to focus on the Hartland segment. Yogerst will talk to Marshalek about organizing the description and times.
- b. Yogerst addressed that the North Shore Middle School is doing a documentary on the Ice Age Trail in spring of 2018.

4. Future meeting topics and meeting schedule - Next meeting will be on December 5, 6:00 pm. January meeting might be canceled. February meeting will be held on February 15, 2018 at 6:00 pm.
