1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of November 1, 2017. A motion was moved to approve the November 1, 2017 meeting minutes. Motion/second (Muezenberger/Van Thiel).

2. Discussion and consideration of:
 - a. Library programs – Kelli Yogerst gave an update about Toddlers and Tyke Hikes. Yogerst will email Lysianne Unruh from the Ice Age Trail Alliance the dates for Tyke Hikes, Toddler Hikes and Discover the Ice Age Trail program which will be held at the Hartland Public Library.
 - b. Recreational programs – Mrs. Yogerst stated that she requested from REI to provide snowshoes for the winter hikes that the Hartland walk club will do.
 - c. Website for Hartland on IATC site – update from the IATC Website Committee members – Dr Muezenburger presented an update on the Village of Hartland Ice Age Trail Community (IATC) website. Dr. Muezenburger and local photographer Miranda Weston are still working on setting up some photoshoots to get take some pictures with people in them. Also want to attach captions on the photos. One question that was raised was asking Ms. Unruh how many people have already visited the Village of Hartland’s IATC website.
 - d. Trail signage/education – One thought was to have the website address listed and then a QR Cod on the signs. Question was raised if the Ice Age Trail Community Committee had an annual budget.
 - e. IATC Partner Program – Pamphlet/Letter – no discussion
 - f. Kiosk update – Van De Ven met with Arrowhead High School teacher who will be building the Kiosk in Nixon Park. The students are now in the process of designing the kiosk. Discussion was held in regards how the students from Arrowhead get the material and where do they get it from. Jackie Perrigo will work on getting prices to print the poster that will go into the Nixon Park Kiosk. Mrs. Yogerst will talk to Ryan Bailey, Village of Hartland Finance Director, about setting up an account at a lumber yard.
 - g. Discussion on installing selfie Kiosk along the Ice Age Trail – Mrs. Perrigo provided an update on what she found out about the Selfie stations that are found throughout the state parks.
 - h. Use of Grant money from the Ice Age Trail Alliance – It was brought up that if the poster for the Kiosk does not cost \$700, what will the committee do with the extra money from the grant. Mrs. Yogerst will touch base with Celtic and see what type of material the poster is printed on.
