Roll Call

Present: Dr. Jim Muenzenberger, Jeannie Georgson, Jeff Romagna and Kelli Yogerst

Yogerst call the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

A motion was made and approved (Yogerst/Romagna) for Dr. Muenzenberger to be the Chair Elect due to Chairperson Van De Ven unable to attend the meeting.

1. Consideration of a motion to approve the Minutes for the meeting of May 2, 2018.
A motion was made and passed (Georgson/Romagna)
2. Discussion and consideration of:
 - a. Library programs - No discussion
 - b. Recreational programs - Next recreational program is Yoga on the Trail. Yogerst will fill out the Ice Age Trail Community Event Reporting Form. Yogerst will put together a letter and send it to Ice Age Trail Alliance. Discussion was held in regards to the National Trails Day hike that was held on June 2, 2018 in Nixon Park. It was reported that 25 individuals participated in the Marsh hike, 32 for the Delafield to Hartland hike and 25 – 30 adults and youth for the Tyke Hike.
 - c. Website for Hartland on IATC site – The group will be meeting on Friday, June 15, 9:00 am – 12:00 pm. Muenzenberger reported that they are making progress and are in the process of picking photos and labeling them.
 - d. Trail signage/education – Muenzenberger put up the remaining signs along the trail that go on the poles indicating the Ice Age Trail path. Discussion on putting up more Hartland Ice Age Trail Community signs up in Hartland. Yogerst will talk to Dave Cox, Village Administrator, about putting up more signs thru Hartland. Yogerst will talk to Dave Cox about putting a bigger sign for IATCC.
 - e. IATC Partner Program – Pamphlet/Letter – It was discussed that Luke Kloberdanz from the Ice Age Trail Alliance would like for us to get these pamphlets out. Georgson is willing to go and hand out pamphlets. Muenzenberger has brought up the program several times but nothing has occurred.
 - f. Kiosk update – The Nixon Park Kiosk is supposed to be done by Thursday, June 7. DPW got padlocks for the Nixon Park Kiosk. Sullivan is raising money for the Kiosk in Centennial. He is doing a fundraiser at the Brat Shack for the Kiosk.
 - g. Discussion on installing selfie Kiosk along the Ice Age Trail – If the Ice Age Trail Alliance wants a selfie station, we should do it. This would be a nice scout project. Yogerst will talk to DPW about doing a selfie station over the winter.
 - h. Future Promotional Events – No Discussion
3. Other items for follow up as necessary
 - a. Connection with/to schools – Yogerst will talk to the Hartland Lakeside School District about implementing the Ice Age Trail into their curriculum.

4. Future meeting topics and meeting schedule – Motion (Muenzenberger/Romagna) was made to not hold a meeting on Tuesday, July 3.
5. Announcements Yogerst will talk to Darlene Igl, Village Clerk, about the candidate for the Ice Age Trail Community Committee position that is vacant. Possible Recreation program: Full Moon hike in the fall. One thought is to do the hike thru the Marsh and have a bonfire in the chimney for the swifts. Participants can meet at the Cottonwood Wayside and walk the Marsh and have a bonfire. October Friday, 26. Start the hike at 7:00 pm and the bonfire can start at 8:00 pm. Yogerst will talk to Dave Dean, Village of Hartland's Fire Chief about helping out.
